

## Call for proposals

# CVON RACE-V Young Talent Program

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CVON consortia contain an allocated budget for the (Young) Talent Program. CVON RACE-V has decided to make this budget available for CVON RACE-V Acceleration and Career Development grants:

1. **RACE V Exchange Program Fellowship** with the purpose of sending out or bringing in top talent scientists (Duration: 3-12 months; Budget: 10-40 K€ per fellowship, start of fellowship before July 1, 2019).
2. **RACE V (Proof-of-Concept) Award** for the purpose of enhancing groundbreaking research in the field of the pathophysiology of atrial fibrillation (PhDs/Post-Docs; Duration: 6-12 months; Budget: 25-50 K€ per project; start of project before July 1, 2019)

### Criteria

- The CVON RACE-V call is open for applications from talented researchers (without excluding those already working for the RACE-V program)
- The proposal should be novel (not part of already funded work) and advance the RACE-V program.
- The focus should be on adding knowledge and techniques to the consortium.
- The proposal should have the potential of generating future funding, for example by generating pilot data, by initiating or strengthening collaborations.
- You must have the support of one of the PI's from RACE-V. Please contact [nicoline.smit@heart-institute.nl](mailto:nicoline.smit@heart-institute.nl) for a complete list of names.

### Proposal template

Proposals should be written in English, using the template on the following pages.

Proposals should clearly describe and include all of the following point:

- The working plan
- The hypothesis
- The activities that add knowledge and techniques to the consortium and strengthen your CV
- Papers to be realised within the project period
- Grant proposals to be submitted
- Relation to the RACE-V program (<https://race-v.org/>)
- Complete budget
- Your CV, based on Dutch VENI CV format (also attached)

The RACE-V Young Talent Program is open to PhD students and Post-Docs.

### Process and deadline

We expect the costs for salary and materials to exceed the amounts awarded in these grants. Therefore, your institution **must** commit scientifically **and** financially to your proposal. In case your project is granted, this commitment will be a condition before your project can start.

The evaluation and ranking of the projects will be done by the International Advisory Board of CVON RACE-V. Budgets can only be claimed at the consortium coordinator UMC Groningen by the RACE-V PI that supports your proposal.

Expected date for communicating the results is May 20, 2019.
